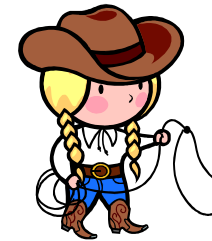
PROGRAM PHILOSOPHY

PROGRAM INFORMATION 2010

Camp Sessions
Are Open To
Preschool
Children Aged 3
Through 5 Years.

CAMP HOURS are 9:00am-1:00pm, Monday through Friday. For younger campers, two part-time slots per class are reserved on a first-requested basis.

WEEKLY CAMP FEE is \$210. Mon/Wed/Fri only is \$151 Tues/Thur only is \$109.

CAMP FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE, unless written notice of cancellation is received 30 days in advance AND the space is filled.

A REFFERAL DISCOUNT of \$20 will be given for each camper referred to CLC. Referred camper must be a child in a family which is new to CLC (preschool or camp). The camper/s must be registered (for full week of camp) and paid before discount is issued.

CAMPERS MUST BE TOILET TRAINED or be a current CLC student.

Registration forms may be dropped off at CLC office or mailed.

EMERGENCY AND MEDICAL FORMS

must be completed and returned to CLC before a child can attend camp. Forms are provided upon registration as needed. Current CLC students do not require new forms.

LUNCH AND DRINK must be sent with each child each day. CLC provides a daily snack with drink. *For a child who requires an Epi-pen for a food or drink allergy, the parent will be required to send in the child's snack each day as well.*

DAILY SUNSCREEN APPLICATION by parents is necessary before each camp day, as outdoor activities are an integral part of our learning fun. Parents also should **CHECK CHILDREN DAILY FOR TICKS** upon returning home.

CAMPERS ARE GROUPED into several classes. Whenever possible, children registered for multiple weeks are placed in the same class each week. While we cannot guarantee that all requests will be met, we do what is possible to fulfill special requests for placement of children together.
